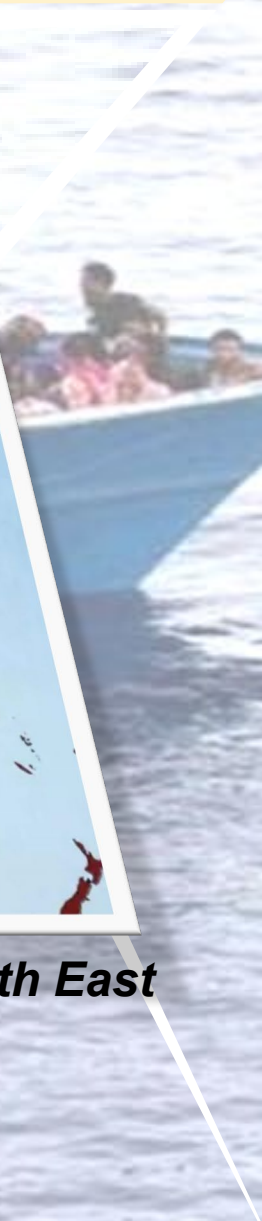

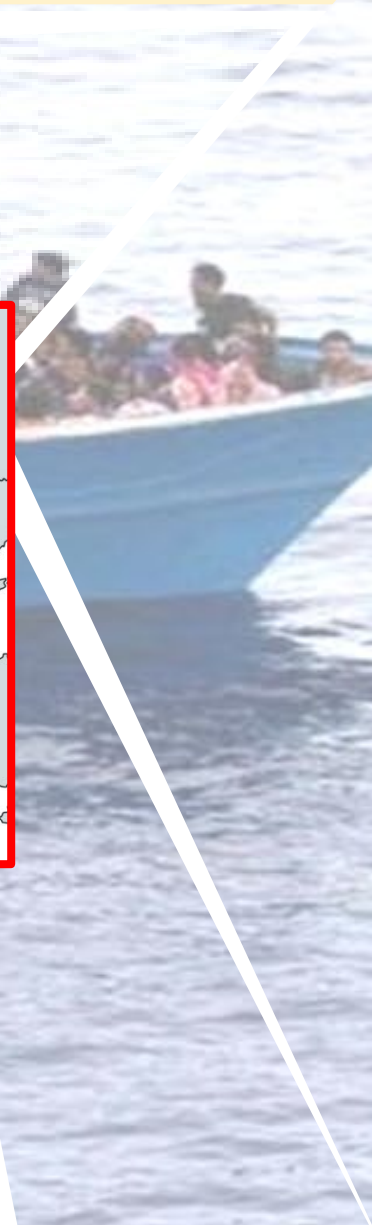
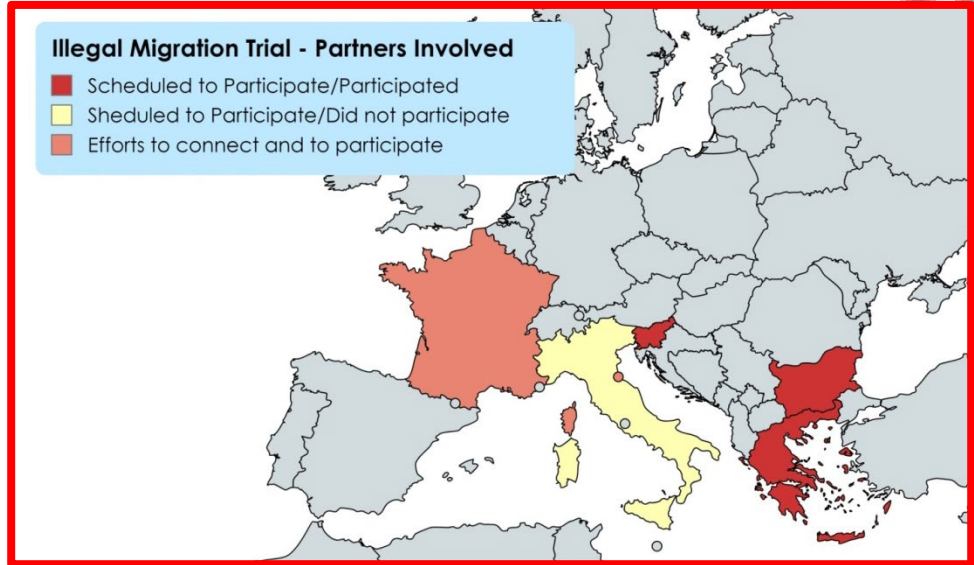
Current Security Environment

Initiator CISE-ALERT partner: Hellenic MOD

Applicable Use Cases (WP2): Use Case 2: Illegal Activities
(Migration/Trafficking)

Storyboard: In order to address the illegal trafficking activities at sea, an Authority A1 may be interested to gather information not yet available in its system from other maritime authorities B,C,D (in the same country or in other EU countries) regarding a suspicious vessel. The aim of this exchange through CISE is to help the Authority B1 to draw a conclusion whether an illegal activity is taking place or not and if needed, to put in place an operation to intercept the suspicious vessel.

Objective

- To combat illegal trafficking in the SE Mediterranean sea

Action Plan

- To Detect suspicious activities at sea
- To Monitor suspected vessels
- To Intercept if needed suspected vessels

Intended Result

- Information Fusion
- To automatically alert partners about a Vessel of Interest
- To exercise and exchange effective Command and Control orders

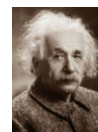




Maritime Command and Control



As Albert Einstein might have advised, C2 must be as simple as possible, and no simpler.



- **Command and control (C2)**: is an essential element of the art and science of naval warfare.
- **Command** is the act of making decisions and ordering action
- **Control** is the act of monitoring and influencing this action.

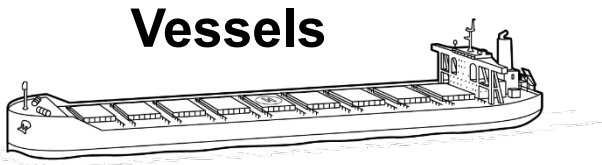

Maritime Operational Difficulties



The CISE solution give the answers to the common operational needs of any maritime operation:

How to collect information about a VOI?

- **Contact each single possible contributor separately by traditional means**

How to alert neighbouring partners about a VOI?

- **Contact each single affected partner separately**

How to alert partners about a maritime incident?

- **Contact them separately**

How to Command and Control assets on-scene?

- **Continuous information briefings among involved partners**





Maritime Operational Difficulties



Nowadays EU Maritime Operations Centers (MOC), work in a rather fragmented way:

- MOC's uses its own Legacy System (LS) to manage maritime incidents.
- LSs do not exchange information
- There is not a single operational picture to be used as a reference by all MOCs

Challenges and Opportunities

- Eliminate manual entry of data by machine to machine exchange of data
- Create common operational picture
- Exchange info in a user friendly environment
