



The Italian Customs and Monopolies Agency (ADM) is interested in monitoring the behavior of a cargo vessel that is expected to arrive in an Italian port. The scope is to verify if the vessel is performing suspected actions when sailing outside the Italian territorial waters (i.e. anomalous route, rendez-vous with small vessels, loss of AIS while sailing). In case of suspected actions or risk profiles reported by CISE-ALERT partners, ADM will require inspection on board before authorizing the transfer of goods from the ship to the final destination. Otherwise, ADM will authorize to speed up logistic and customs procedures, facilitating land-based operations and the rapid transfer of goods from the port to the place of destination.



The scenario involves

- Agenzia delle Dogane e Monopoli, Italy (ADM)
- Republic Ministry of National Defence, Greece (HMOD),
- Ministrstvo za Infrastrukturo, Slovenia (Mzi).
- Agenzia Spaziale Italiana, Italy (ASI),
- EU Satellite Center (SatCen)

This scenario involves especially the Countries facing the Aegean and the Adriatic Sea, as well as the operators of Italian and European satellite systems.



# SPREADING RANGE FOR PRE-CLEARING OPERATIONS

TRIAL SCENARIO DESCRIPTION

1 Ships depart from the port of Damietta in Egypt and head towards Trieste. CISE will be used to log and share departure details, ensuring all relevant maritime authorities and stakeholders are informed of the vessel's journey and its cargo.

2 The ships will be followed via satellite and traditional detection systems. CISE will integrate satellite tracking data with traditional detection systems, providing a comprehensive monitoring platform. This enables real-time tracking and situational awareness for all involved parties, enhancing the safety and security of the voyage.



3 Any alerts that occur will be routed through the CISE ALERT network and managed in collaboration with project partners. If any alerts are triggered, such as deviations from the planned route, suspicious activities, or emergency situations, CISE ALERT will automatically distribute the alerts to all relevant stakeholders. The network will facilitate coordinated response efforts, ensuring prompt and efficient management of any incidents in collaboration with project partners.
